Located in the western Caribbean Sea at the second largest barrier reef in the world, this exotic tropical island's beautiful turquoise waters are home to fishing, submarine tours, snorkeling, and of course scuba diving. The Largest of the Bay Islands, Roatan is situated 35 miles off the North coast of Honduras.

One of the many popular dives takes you through the Prince Albert. This wrecked tanker is 140 ft long and is filled with many fascinating sea creatures. This wreck lies in the waters just off of CoCo View Beach Resort. There are many dive sites within the Roatan Marine Reserve, with deep drop-offs, caverns, swim throughs, and canyons, just a short boat ride from Coco View. You can expect to see many different fish, lobsters, rays and so much more.
